#### ♦ ISSUE

The board is being asked to adopt the proposed amendments to 4 AAC 33.605- 4 AAC 33.690, Funding for the Improvement of Internet Speed at Public Schools, dealing with increased internet speed for districts through the School Broadband Assistance Grant (BAG) program.

## ♦ BACKGROUND

- On March 25, 2024, the 33<sup>rd</sup> Legislature passed HB 193 into law. The statute amended AS 14.03.127 *Funding for internet services* to provide Alaska school districts with funding to assist eligible schools in their school districts to increase their download speeds to 100 megabits per second (Mbps) download speed for internet services. This is an increase from the prior speed of 25 Mbps.
- The statute offers eligible school district funding to bolster services to 100 Mbps through the Alaska School Broadband Assistance Grant program (BAG).
- The changes to the current regulations include the update of BAG maximum download speed from 25 Mbps to 100 Mbps, a clear definition of "initial negotiated capacity", required information to report in the BAG application, and a simplified process for determining date of initial negotiated capacity.
- The public comment period was open from August 29, 2024, to September 30, 2024.
- Public comments follow the Agenda Item 4C.
- A copy of the proposed regulations follows Agenda Item 4C.
